New Legacy Grant Recipients

\$60,000

Foothills Food Bank & Resource Center, Phoenix:

Funds will help build a new facility and resource room that will allow the organization to enhance its capacity to address the underlying factors contributing to food insecurity.

\$32,000

Manzanita Outreach, Cottonwood:

Grant will be used to purchase a refrigerated van that will expand the organization's ability to address the issue of food insecurity in the Verde Valley.

\$20,000

2023 TAX STATEMENTS

If you receive eStatements, your 2023 tax statements will be available by January 31, 2024. We will provide Form 1099-INT for members who earned over \$10.00 in interest and Form 1098 for over \$600.00 paid in mortgage interest.

To find the documentation needed for your 2023 tax returns, complete the following:

1. Log into online banking.
2. Select the three-dot menu on your desktop or the Menu tab in mobile banking.
3. Select Documents and Statements.

If you've opted out of receiving eStatements, your 2023 tax statements will be sent by mail. Expect to receive them by mid-February.
